## Postgraduate International Travel Awards

### Purpose:

To support travel to overseas conferences **in the first half of 2010**.

### Eligibility:

Full-time PhD students who have completed at least one full year of their PhD (counted on the application deadline, see below) who were full\* ASI members in 2008 and paid their subscription for 2009 before 1<sup>st</sup> April. Students who have previously received an ASI Postgraduate International Travel Award are ineligible.

*\*Full membership can be student or ordinary member, but not interim.*

### Assessment Criteria:

Scientific excellence and clarity of abstract, publication record, recommendation of supervisor, and likely professional benefits of the proposed travel, as judged by the ASI Executive Committee or their nominees. The committee reserves the right not to make an award.

### Value:

A variable number of prizes will be awarded, subject to funding availability, between the Postdoctoral and Postgraduate International Travel Awards. Postgraduate and Postdoctoral candidates will be considered separately. Each prize may be worth up to \$5,000
