



The fourth ASI Advanced Immunology School will be held from 14th-17th May 2024 at Long Point Conference Centre, Long Point, Sydney, NSW. The theme for the 2024 AIS will be 'Immune Communication'.

The ASI-AIS aims to provide training in advanced and cutting edge basic and clinical immunological research for early career researchers with a sound background knowledge in the principles of immunology in a friendly scientific environment.
